### Hearings set for Palm Coast Parkway plan

The City of Palm Coast, with the Florida Department of Transportation, has scheduled a public hearing on proposed improvements to Palm Coast Parkway from Cypress Point Parkway/Boulder Rock Drive to Florida Park Drive.

The hearing will begin as an open house at 6 p.m. on March 16 at the Palm Coast Community Center, 305

Palm Coast Pkwy NE. A formal presentation will follow at 7 p.m.

Immediately following the formal presentation, officials will open the meeting for public comment.

The hearing is being held to allow interested parties a chance to express their views about the location, conceptual design and social, economic and environmental effects of the proposed improvements to that area of Palm Coast Parkway.

The proposed improvements consist of widening the roadway from a four-lane to a six-lane divided facility with shared-use paths on both sides and improvements at the intersections at Cypress Point Parkway and Old Kings Road.

Minimal additional right-of-way may be required along the 1.23-mile project.

Work is scheduled to begin in 2012.

The Draft Project Development Summary Report (PDSR) and environmental documents, along with other pertinent information, will be available for public review during normal business hours at the City of Palm Coast offices located at 160 Cypress Point Parkway.

These materials will also be available at the hearing site from 6 p.m. until the end of the meeting/hearing.

Those who want to submit written statements and other exhibits, in place of or in addition to oral statements, may do so at the hearing or by sending them to the City of Palm Coast, 160 Cypress Point Parkway, Suite No. B106, Palm Coast, FL 32164.

All exhibits or statements postmarked no later than March 26 will become a part of the public hearing record.

Public participation is solicited without regard to race, color, national origin, age, sex,
